## 1. Review of project Status

- Five bids have been received with the lowest lower than the engineer's estimate. Construction likely will not start until late summer
- CCG Awards will be announced at the end of March or beginning of April. GBD applies for the Vermont Walkway
- 2. San Bruno Avenue
  - Once contractors are chosen and the amount of funding is known, Trent will let us know when Phase 2 design can continue
  - The committee emphasizes that now is the time to work on San Bruno Avenue
  - Sheldon got an update from the VSS contact regarding a wall
  - Sheldon points out that San Bruno Avenue problems is what initiated the Potrero Gateway project, and we need to make sure San Bruno Avenue is addressed.
