Eco-patch Workday Tasks

- Weeding of oxalis across all patches
- □ If you have them, bring gloves, clippers, loppers, shovels, and trowels
- Cut pruned bits into smaller pieces to leave onsite as mulch

Coastal Scrub

- Prune Lizard Tail
- Deadhead Seaside Daisy

Strawberry Coastal Prairie

- Cut back Tufted Hairgrass
- □ Plant Varicolored Lupine (5) from Watershed Nursery

Fescue Coastal Prairie

- □ Cut back fescue (2/3rds back)
- Cut back Dune Sagewort
- □ Plant yarrow (9) leftover from last open garden

Coyote Bush Scrub

- prune Monkey Flower to approx 4" to 6" from ground- make sure some leaves remain
- □ Plant Artemisia californica (California Sagebrush) (1) **if we get one**

Coffeeberry Scrub

- □ prune Coffeeberry
- □ Prune Ceanothus to maintain smaller more compact form and so that it looks better in general- do not prune back branches wider than a finger- avoid heavy cuts into woody tissue (ideally this would have been done immediately after flowering to not accidentally remove next years flowers)
- □ Cut back California Melic Grass
- □ Plant California Bee Plant (6) from Oaktown Nursery

Oak Woodland

Cut back California Melic Grass

Oak Savanna

- Cut back California Field Sedge, Prairie Junegrass
- Prune Coyote Mint to encourage full dense growth to avoid leggy woodiness
- Cut back Dune Gilia

Serpentine Meadow

Cut back California Field Sedge, California Fescue (2/3rds back), California Melic Grass, Franciscan Wallflower (to ground)
