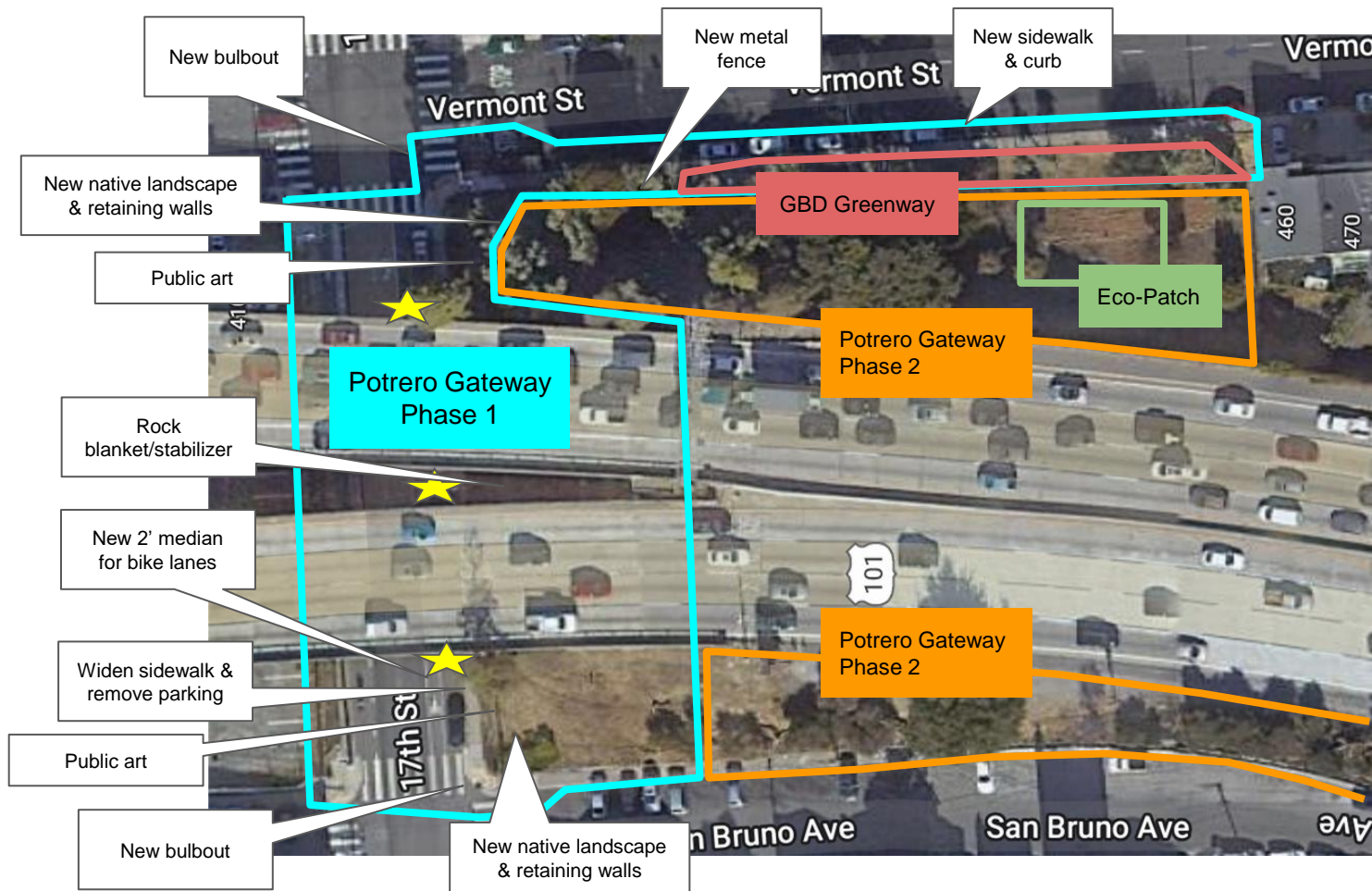

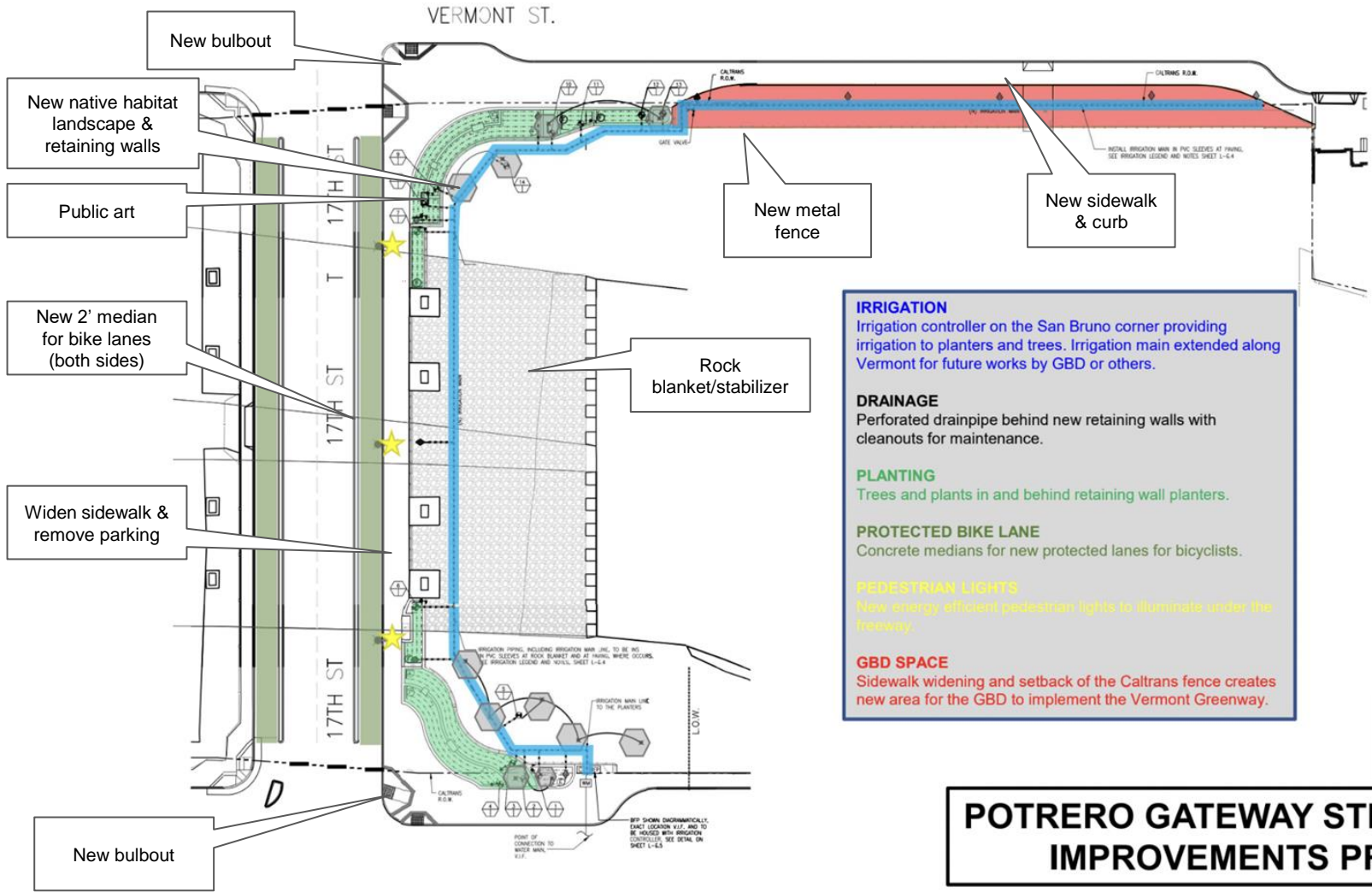

Potrero Gateway & Related Projects (annotated)



IRRIGATION
 Irrigation controller on the San Bruno corner providing irrigation to planters and trees. Irrigation main extended along Vermont for future works by GBD or others.

DRAINAGE
 Perforated drainpipe behind new retaining walls with cleanouts for maintenance.

PLANTING
 Trees and plants in and behind retaining wall planters.

PROTECTED BIKE LANE
 Concrete medians for new protected lanes for bicyclists.

PEDESTRIAN LIGHTS
 New energy efficient pedestrian lights to illuminate under the freeway.

GBD SPACE
 Sidewalk widening and setback of the Caltrans fence creates new area for the GBD to implement the Vermont Greenway.
